Paint and paint-related products (Oil-based paint, thinners, stains, etc.)	By volume	\$8.00

Small Propane Cylinder (1 gallon)	Each	\$1.00

### HHW Drop-Off Procedure and Special Notes

- **The HHW Collection Program is open to Grand County, Utah and San Juan, Utah residents ONLY.** Proof of residency (Driver's License or utility bill) is required prior to drop-off. No commercial waste, waste from businesses, or out-of-state HHW will be accepted. Residential property management agencies (i.e., overnight accommodations management companies) are not authorized to bring materials generated from rental units.
- Residents may drop up to fifty (50) pounds of HHW per visit. No containers over five (5) gallons will be accepted, excluding propane cylinders.
- **ALL CONTAINERS MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED, IN THE ORIGINAL CONTAINER, AND FREE OF LEAKS. CSWA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY MATERIALS.**

***NO Ammunition/explosives, Asbestos – containing materials, Pharmaceuticals, Hypodermic needles/syringes, Medical or biological waste, Radioactive materials, Smoke detectors, Unknown chemicals, etc.***
