WHEREAS, a public hearing to hear comments on the proposed revised fee structure was advertised in the *Times-Independent* at Moab, Grand County, State of Utah on the on the 7th of December 2023, noticed on the Utah Public Notice Website at <https://www.utah.gov/pmn/index.html>, and said fee structure was available for public inspection in advance of the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, such hearing was held at 6:00 p.m. on December 13, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a written public comment period was allowed through 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 13, 2023; and

WHEREAS, verbal public comments were permitted during the public comments portion of the public hearing online via Zoom Video Communications, and all public comments received during the public hearing through the end of the public comment period were taken into consideration;

¹ = Green/yard waste containing contaminants will be charged at the construction and demolition debris rate. Root balls interbedded with dirt and rocks does not constitute recoverable green waste, cannot be compacted, and will be charged at the concrete and asphalt rate.

² = Construction and demolition debris loads containing concrete and/or asphalt will be charged at the concrete and asphalt rate.

³ = Scrap steel must be free of other debris and materials. Old lawn mowers and other equipment are accepted as long as all fluids have been removed/drained. Non-freon containing appliances are accepted as long as they do not contain polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). Freon-containing appliances are accepted at the Canyonlands Transfer Station located at 2295 South Highway 191. Scrap metal is containerized and relocated to the Canyonlands Transfer Station for processing and storage prior to reclamation, and consequently, is accepted for free at the transfer station.

⁴ = Clean fill dirt must be free of organic material and other debris, including but not limited to tree limbs, grasses, large rocks, and boulders. Dirt containing organic material and other debris will be charged at the construction and demolition debris rate. Projects with large volumes of clean fill are assessed an equipment usage fee after 120 cubic yards of clean fill and for every 120 cubic yards thereafter.

⁵ = Tires and bulk loads of tires with rims are charged 1.5 times the applicable per unit fee above.

⁶ = Acceptance of materials beyond regular hours of operations will be considered for large commercial projects and must be approved in advance by Authority administrative staff.

- **ALL LOADS MUST BE COVERED AND/OR SECURED. Unsecured Loads will be charged double disposal fees.**
- **Landfill Charges for cleanup of loads containing prohibited materials and/or tipped in the wrong location: 1.5 times the fully burdened hourly rate for employee, equipment, and administrative overhead rates.**

The Moab Landfill is permitted to accept certain types of construction and demolition debris, which restricts most furniture and mattresses from disposal at the facility. Due to ongoing requests and for the convenience of our residential¹ customers, the Moab Landfill is now accepting the following items that will be rerouted to the Klondike Landfill for disposal. These items will need to be offloaded to a separate staging area as directed by Solid Waste Authority staff and will be charged as indicated below.

Commercial loads and large quantities of bulky waste material, including furniture from overnight accommodations and other rentals, are generally NOT accepted and will be charged two-times the above-listed rates. Commercial-derived bulky waste items should be delivered directly to the Canyonlands Transfer Station to qualify for the above-listed rates.*

² *Oversized furniture exceeding four (4) cubic yards of total airspace will be charged the oversized furniture rate plus \$6 per each additional cubic yard per item.*

- * Haul rates include disposal/reclamation rates, where applicable.
- * Container relocation rates are the same as delivery rates.
- * Concrete/Asphalt containers can only be filled to 75% of the container capacity in order to adhere to transportation weight restrictions.
- * Scrap metal must be free from other debris/trash. Depending on the amount, scrap metal with contamination will be charged a sorting fee or disposal fee, which may include a 2-hour roundtrip to the Klondike Landfill.
- * Waste tire loads containing debris/trash will be charged the applicable sorting fee plus additional disposal charges, where applicable.
- * Cardboard hauls containing large amounts of debris/trash will be charged the MSW and C&D haul rate.
- * Tires, appliances, and scrap metal loaded into cleanup containers mixed with MSW and C&D materials are acceptable but will incur container sorting fees specified above.
- * All Special Wastes (non-friable asbestos, contaminated soils, etc.) require approval from Solid Waste Authority management via the issuance of a Special Waste Profile and Manifest prior to container delivery.
- * Containers that do not get hauled at least once per month will incur two times the above-listed container use fees (CUF) for each container per day beginning on the second month after the container delivery date.
- * Fuel surcharge – When the average price of Diesel in Utah exceeds \$4.29 per gallon (per the Dept. of Energy’s U.S. Energy Information Website at <http://www.eia.gov/>), a 5% surcharge will apply to each roll-off service. An additional 5% surcharge will apply every time the average rate exceeds an additional 25 cents per gallon.

RESTRICTIONS

- * The maximum allowable weight for any 10-CY or 18-CY container is six (6) tons.
- * The maximum allowable weight for any 20-CY or 30-CY container is ten (10) tons.
- * Containers can only be hauled when loaded level with the top of the container. Overloaded containers will NOT be hauled.
- * Overloaded containers will be charged container sorting fees specified above. Unless prearranged, we do not accept dirt, rock, sod, stumps, root balls, or asphalt shingles.
- * No hazardous materials or hazardous waste accepted, including liquids, chemicals, and paints of any kind.
