- ³ = Scrap steel must be free of other debris and materials. Old lawn mowers and other equipment are accepted as long as all fluids have been removed/drained. Non-freon containing appliances are accepted as long as they do not contain polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). Freon-containing appliances are accepted at the Canyonlands Transfer Station located at 2295 South Highway 191.
