CLASS B CDL TRUCK DRIVER

DUTIES:

Operate heavy-duty trucks and is responsible for the collection and/or hauling of residential/commercial municipal solid waste and/or recyclable materials. Drivers transport material to a disposal, reclamation, or transfer facility when at legal capacity. Driver safely maneuvers vehicle in residential/commercial environments. Navigates high traffic and congested roadways, driveways, alleyways, and lots. Performs a variety of physical tasks with the ability to lift, pull, or push up to 75 pounds. Ability to work outside where the applicant may be exposed to varying and potentially extreme weather conditions, noise levels, dust levels, odors, construction environment, potentially hazardous or toxic waste, and related items that may be present in municipal solid waste. The employee is required to attend safety and training and refresher courses as required and perform other duties, as requested.

REQUIREMENTS:

High school diploma or G.E.D. with a minimum of three years of experience in heavy equipment operations. Five or more years preferred with knowledge, training, and experience in complex heavy equipment operations utilizing a variety of heavy equipment. Ability to perform basic math computations such as cubic yardage, volume of cylinders and rectangles, calculation of weights (e.g., pounds to tons), rounding; ability to be trained to operate construction equipment; some knowledge of general maintenance and repair. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age and must hold a valid class B CDL license and have a clean Motor Vehicle Record (MVR). Must be able to pass a pre-employment DOT physical and Drug and Alcohol test. Must be legally eligible to work in the United States. Must operate in accordance with established Health and Safety policies and procedures, DOT (Department of Transportation) requirements as well as all local, state, and federal laws. Ability to work outside where the applicant may be exposed to varying and potentially extreme weather conditions, noise levels, dust levels, odors, construction environment, potentially hazardous or toxic waste, and related items that may be present in municipal solid waste. The employee is required to attend safety and training sessions and perform other duties, as requested.
