### **DUTIES:**

Performs preventative maintenance services and inspections, troubleshoots, repairs, and rebuilds major components on fleet vehicles, commercial motor vehicles, heavy equipment, and facilities. Ensures accurate diagnosis and effective repair and/or replacement of components in accordance with the established district, county, state, and federal regulations. Must maintain work orders and similar record tracking systems including scheduled maintenance programs. Must be able to operate a variety of heavy equipment including but not limited to dozers, loaders, scrapers, compactors, forklifts, and over the road vehicles. Ability to work outside where applicant may be exposed to varying and potentially extreme weather conditions, noise levels, dust levels, odors, construction environment, potentially hazardous or toxic waste, and related items that may be present in municipal solid waste.

### **MINIMAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

High school diploma or G.E.D. and a minimum of three (3) years of experience in automotive/truck and heavy equipment maintenance and repair with completion of an accredited vocational technical school program with one year of fleet experience recommended. Proficiency in vehicle and equipment diagnosis and repair, including working knowledge of fuel, ignition, cooling, mechanical, suspension, drive train, engine, transmission, hydraulic, electrical, and air brake systems. Must be able to pass a pre-employment Drug and Alcohol test. Legally eligible to work in the United States. Must operate in accordance with established Health and Safety policies and procedures.
