Tires are containerized and relocated to the Moab Landfill for storage prior to recycling/reclamation and, consequently, are accepted at the Moab landfill for 50% of the Transfer Station price. Heavy equipment tires are NOT accepted at the Transfer Station and must be delivered to the Moab Landfill.	Each	\$ 8.00

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program Procedures

• **The HHW Collection Program is open to Grand and San Juan County, Utah residents ONLY.** Proof of residency (Driver's License or utility bill) is required prior to drop-off. No commercial/business waste or out-of-state HHW will be accepted. Residential property management agencies (i.e., overnight accommodations management companies) are not authorized to bring materials generated from rental units.

• Residents may drop up to fifty (50) pounds of HHW per visit. No containers over five (5) gallons will be accepted, excluding propane cylinders.

ALL CONTAINERS MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED, IN THE ORIGINAL CONTAINER, AND FREE OF LEAKS. CSWA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY MATERIALS.

Facility Procedures

- **ALL LOADS MUST BE COVERED AND/OR SECURED.** Unsecured loads will be charged double disposal fees.
- **All loads are subject to random load inspections.**
- Total invoice ticket fees are rounded to the nearest whole dollar (i.e., 0.01 to 0.49 rounds down & 0.50 to 0.99 rounds up)
- Finance charges of 1.5% per month may be charged for charge accounts past due over 30 days
