What we can recycle in Moab

<p>See-through plastic beverage bottles (#1 plastics). <i>Rinsed. No lids.</i></p>	
<p>Natural-color (partly transparent) plastic jugs and bottles (#2 plastics). <i>Rinsed. No lids.</i></p>	
<p>Glass jars and bottles. <i>Washed (no left over food). No lids.</i></p>	
<p>Aluminum and steel/tin cans. <i>Rinsed/washed.</i></p>	
<p>White and pastel office/copy paper and computer paper (with perforated edges) <i>No card stock, glossy ads, sticky notes, newspapers, catalogs, magazines, file folders, no junk mail, or envelopes.</i></p>	
<p>Corrugated cardboard (wavy layer provides stability and padding)  <i>Please flatten and stack.</i></p>
